CHARLOTTESVILLE WINE TOUR

3 Days - 2 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 Depart from your hometown and travel to Charlottesville, VA. Upon arrival, visit Monticello, the mountaintop home of Thomas Jefferson. The house is a remarkable integration of classical architecture and modern innovation designed by Jefferson and built on the mountain top where he had played as a boy. The home's name means "Little Mountain". Next, enjoy lunch at Michie Tavern "Get A Taste of the 18th Century!" and then spend time exploring the General Store. Following lunch, visit the King Family Vineyards for a guided tasting on the family farm situated in the heart of the Monticello American Viticultural Area, home to some of the best vineyards in Virginia. After your tasting, check in to you hotel prior to dinner at Wood Grill Buffet.
- Day 2 Following breakfast at your hotel, depart for the University of Virginia for a guided tour of the Rotunda, Academical Village, and Memorial to Enslaved Laborers. The Rotunda at the University of Virginia was designed by Thomas Jefferson as the architectural and academic heart of the University's community of scholars. He named the University's original buildings the "Academical Village" based on the Jeffersonian principle that learning is a lifelong process, and that interaction between faculty and students is vital to the pursuit of knowledge. Following your tour, depart for Mount Ida Reserve for lunch and guided wine tasting. The Tasting Room & Taphouse brings a new dimension to Mount Ida Reserve's time-honored tradition of hospitality. A warm, relaxed, yet refined atmosphere. Later, visit Eastwood Farm & Winery for another guided wine tasting experience a chance to sample Virginia wines, learn about the winery and Virginia viticulture, and be guided through the tasting notes and winemaking process for each of the wines. After the tasting, return to the hotel to freshen up before enjoying dinner at Timberwood Tap House.
- Day 3 Enjoy breakfast and a leisurely morning at the hotel prior to checking out.. Then visit James Monroe's Highland and meet Mr. Monroe! Through Highland's architecture and landscape you will hear the story of the lost and found main house, and how Highland and its inhabitants reflected the economic fortunes of the growing United States. Following lunch on your own at Dairy Market, depart for Keswick Vineyards for wine tasting. Pick your own flight and enjoy the natural beauty of Keswick, Virginia in the foothills of the Southwest Mountains Afterwards, enjoy a Southern Comfort food dinner at Three Notch'd Craft Kitchen & Brewery. Three Notch'd has been brewing up award winning beer since 2013, so an alcoholic drink is included with dinner! After dinner, depart for home with lasting memories of your Charlottesville Wine Tour!
